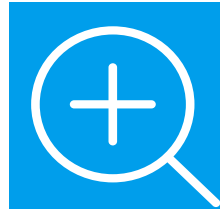


# Project Management Services for Server & Application Migration & Network Integration

## BUSINESS PROBLEM

- A Fortune 500 healthcare services company acquired new hospitals through merger and acquisition activity and needed to integrate the hospitals into their network.
- Challenges included:
  - Duplicate staff and inefficient IT management processes
  - Lack of software/hardware consolidated buying power
  - Technology disparity causing long-term, incomplete integration
- Client needed architectural expertise to develop a modern network design and migration plan that would integrate into their existing network.



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

- GreenPages worked with the client to assess their current Active Directory and related infrastructure/networking/compute environment
- GreenPages developed a new design and migration plan to deliver a network future state based on the customer's standards and needs
- One unique challenge was developing a corporate 2.0 compute environment and managing the impact of that on each of the migration targets into the source; this visioning *extended the project significantly while the parent company negotiated terms and technology* with the holdings.
- Project management was integral in managing scope, unforeseen issues, risk, quality, and communication.



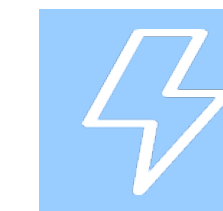
## COST IMPACT

- Scope management ensured on-time, on-budget service delivery
- Tight attention to detail guarded against costly scope creep
- Adjusted plan when changes occurred to minimize unnecessary costs or delays



## RISK IMPACT

- Proactive risk management to resolve issues before they occurred
- Proactive problem resolution using predefined processes
